## 7. **Professional Experience.**

- (b) Joined Submarines Dec 86.
- (c) <u>Submarine Experience</u>. Spent the first 25 years of service career on board submarines (less time spent on courses and other operational appointments) and commanded three conventional submarines and culminated in the command of INS Chakra the Nuclear Submarine taken on lease from Russia.
- (d) Exposure to Russian Navy. During the training and commissioning process of INS Chakra I had very good exposure to the Russians concepts and technology. Imbibed a very high degree of technical skills especially on Nuclear Physics and related aspect of Nuclear and Radiation Safety. Can read and speak Russian fluently. The knowledge of Russian language has helped me to access open source articles which are originally in Russian and are not available or poorly translated or interpreted in English language.
- (e) <u>NHQ Experience</u>. After extended period spent on board submarines was posted in Naval Headquarters where I was looking after the process of taking over our indigenous nuclear submarines from the ATV Programme into the Indian Navy. In that capacity I gained immense experience of the safety (nuclear) and huge infrastructural requirements for nuclear submarines.
